**Livorno, Italy** (Gateway Port to Florence ) This beautiful Italian seaport lies on the shore of the Ligurian Sea. Enjoy an included shore excursion to Florence, known for its art and architecture. Every street, every square and winding alley of Florence is a showcase for Romanesque, Gothic and Renaissance grandeur. Among the wealth of masterpieces to be found in Florence, you'll see the **Piazza della Signoria** with its **Neptune Fountain** and **Vecchio Palace**, the **Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral** which houses **Michelangelo's unfinished Pietá**, the **Baptistry** which features Ghiberti's famous **Gates of Paradise** and the **Academy** where you can view some of **Michelangelo's finished and unfinished work**, including the awe-inspiring **David**.

**Monte Carlo, Monaco** Monaco, home of the royal Grimaldi family, is a principality of fairy-tale beauty. Highlights: the Royal Palace and boulevards lined with Parisian couturiers.

**Golfe de Porto, Les Calanques** (Scenic cruising) The coastline of France from Marseille to Cassis is scalloped with narrow inlets known as Les Calanques, where jagged white cliffs plunge into clear turquoise seas.

**Barcelona, Spain** Barcelona is a lively mix of Catalán tradition and modern style. Stroll elegant Las Ramblas and marvel at the genius of Picasso and Gaudi.

**Palma de Mallorca, Spain** (Balearic Islands) Among Palma's lovely sights are the Gothic-style Bellver Castle, a 13th-century cathedral and the Almudaina Palace, once home to Mallorcan kings.

**La Goulette, Tunisia** (Tunis and Carthage) Tunis, the nearby capital, offers a bustling medina as well as the Bardo Museum, famed for its collection of mosaics and major finds from nearby Carthage.

**Palermo, Italy** (Sicily) Traces of Roman, Arab and Norman influences mix here. Highlights; the Norman Palace with its golden Byzantine mosaics.

**Naples, Italy** Located on the southern coast of Italy, Naples has spectacular scenery that attracts artists from around the world. Enjoy an included excursion to ancient **Pompeii** where you will visit the spectacular ruins that were covered by the eruption of **Mt. Vesuvius** in 79 A.D. The city remained buried and undiscovered for almost 1500 years until excavation began in 1748. These excavations continue today, providing insight into life during the Roman Empire.

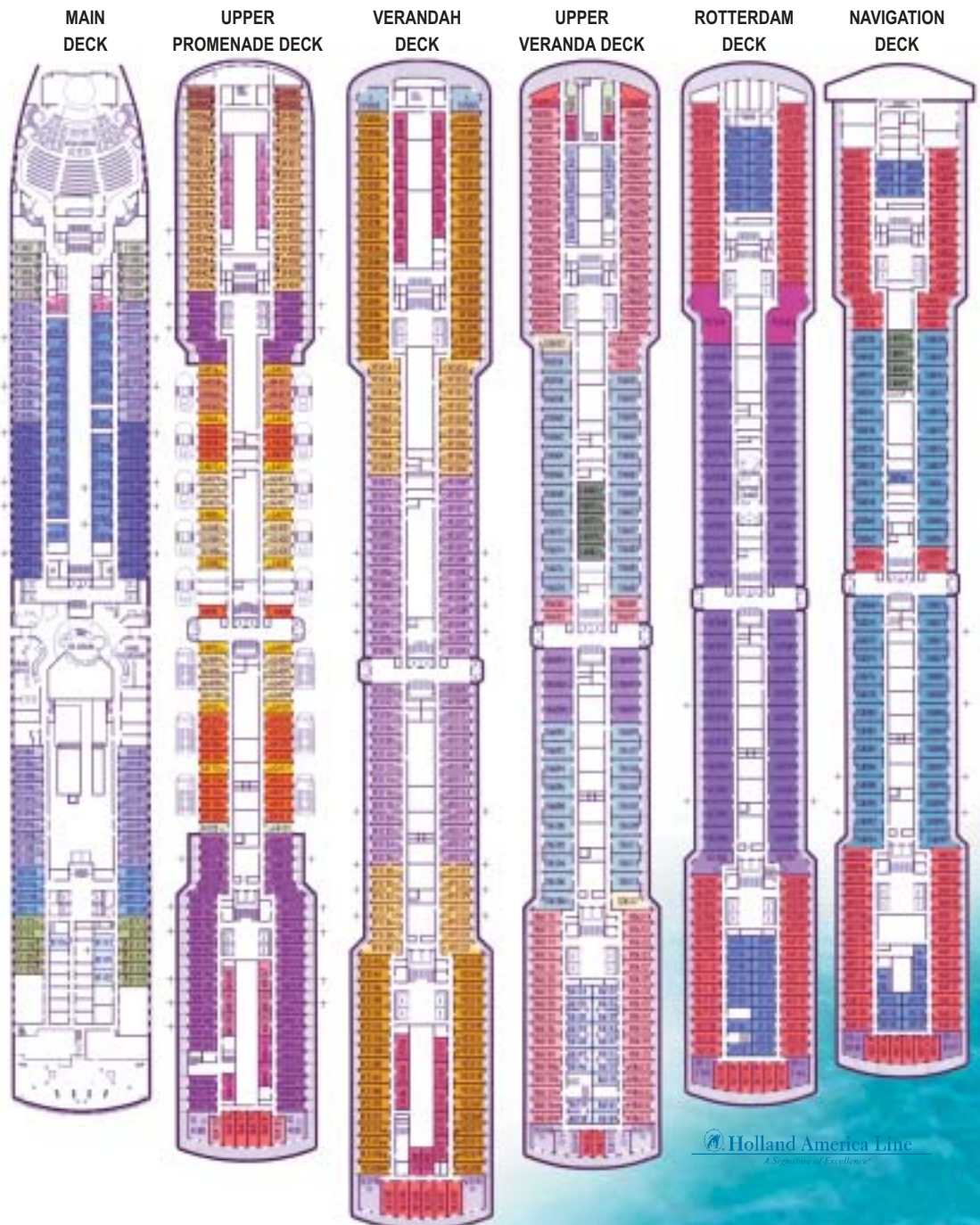
